SUBJECT: Scoping for an Environmental Assessment for Proposed Seismic Upgrades at Raymond G. Murphy VA Medical Center, Albuquerque, New Mexico

Dear Valued Stakeholder,

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) proposes to address seismic deficiencies at the Raymond G. Murphy VA Medical Center, located at 1501 San Pedro Drive Southeast in Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, New Mexico (Figure 1). The purpose of the Proposed Action is to address existing seismic deficiencies. The Proposed Action is needed to improve safety for Veterans, staff, and visitors, and to ensure the continuity of health care services to Veterans. VA proposes to perform seismic upgrades to eight buildings.

VA is preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) to assess the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed seismic upgrades at the Medical Center. VA will prepare the EA in accordance with the regulations implementing the procedural provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969 (42 U.S. Code 4321-4370h), as implemented by the Council on Environmental Quality regulations (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 1500-1508), and VA Implementing Regulations (38 CFR Part 26). The EA will evaluate the potential direct and indirect impacts on the human environment resulting from the Proposed Action.
